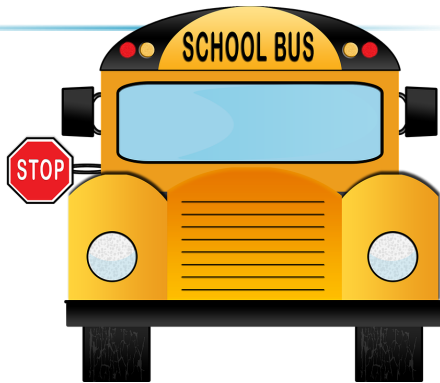

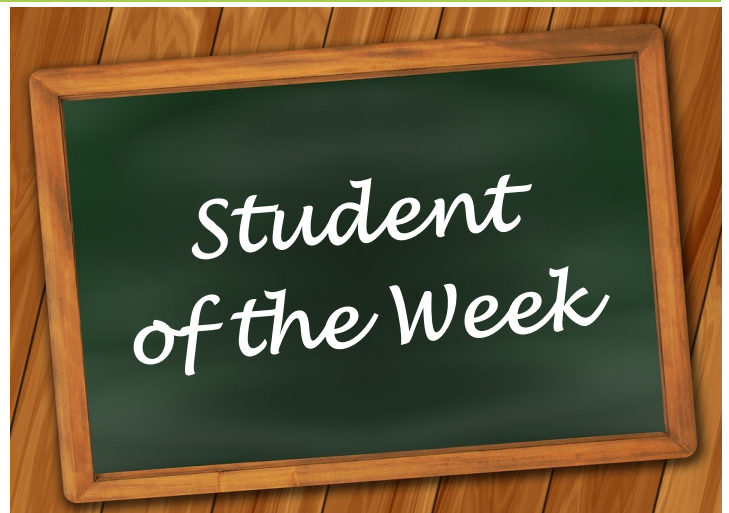

JUNIOR CHESS TOURNAMENT

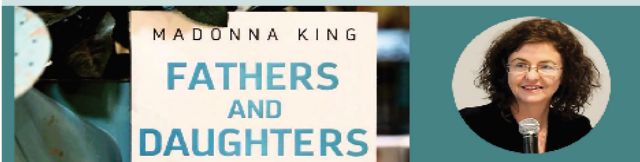
