HOLY WEEK

As we journey through the sacred season of Lent, we approach Holy Week with hearts full of reflection and hope. Holy Week is the most important week in the Church's liturgical calendar, as it commemorates the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of Jesus Christ. It is a time for prayer, reflection, and coming together as a community of faith to remember God's love for us.

As St Patrick's, we are blessed to mark this significant time of year with various activities and reflections that allow our students to deepen their understanding of Jesus' journey and the significance of Easter.

Here is an outline of the events planned for Holy Week:

Palm Sunday Reflection (4B and 4K) – Monday 8.40am in the Multi

Students in 4B and 4K will lead us in a thoughtful reflection on the events of Palm Sunday, when Jesus entered Jerusalem to the joyful cries of "Hosanna!" This is a time to reflect on welcoming Jesus into our lives with open hearts.

Holy Thursday Meditation (4F) – Tuesday 8.40am in the Multi

Year 4 F will guide us in a meditation on the Last Supper, where Jesus shared His final meal with His disciples and gave us the gift of the Eucharist. This will be a time to reflect on the themes of love, service, and sacrifice.

Good Friday Commemoration (5S) - Wednesday 8:40am in the Multi

Year 5S will lead our school in a solemn commemoration of Good Friday, the day Jesus gave His life for us on the cross. We will take this time to remember His ultimate sacrifice and what it means for us today.

Easter Prayer (Prep and Year 6) – Thursday 9am in the Multi

On Easter Sunday, we rejoice in the Resurrection of Jesus, the cornerstone of our faith. Prep and Year 6 students will lead us in a special Easter prayer service to celebrate the joy and hope of the Risen Christ.

Easter Hat Parade (Prep to Year 3) - Thursday 10am in the Multi

Our younger students from Prep to Year 3 will bring the joy of Easter to life with an Easter Hat Parade. We look forward to seeing the creative and colourful designs they've been working on!

Mini Fair

To conclude our Holy Week celebrations, we will hold our annual Mini Fair from 11:15 am, featuring fun activities and stalls for all students to enjoy. Parents are welcome to join us for this joyful event. Students may go home with their parents from 12:30 pm.

BUNDABERG DISTRICT U12 SCHOOL SPORTS TRIALS—2026

Trial information will be advised in the school's newsletter each week detailing trial information for upcoming individual and team events.

Gaining selection in a Bundaberg District Team is the first step on the pathway to representing Wide Bay and Queensland. To represent Bundaberg District, students must be born 2014, 2015 & 2016 (only exceptional 10 year old students will be given permission to trial in team sports). The majority of team sport trials occur in February and March.

Please be aware of the following points:

- Team sports are selected in an U12 category and it is very unlikely that a 10 year old student would be selected, with the exception of Rugby League. Rugby League selects students in U10, U11 and U12 categories due to the contact nature of the sport.
- Bundaberg District trials are not 'have a go' trials. St Patrick's has a responsibility for sending students who we feel display high ability in the chosen sport and a high level of behaviour.
- Students wishing to trial must have a consent form issued by the school with authorisation from Mr Plumb, Ms Gollshewsky or Mr Egan. Students will not be able to participate in the trials without a ***Bundaberg District Primary Schools nomination form***.
- Cross Country and Athletics nominations will be made by the school after our school carnivals. Swimming & Aquathlon are the exceptions – Wide Bay School Sport are responsible for the selection of these teams.
